16	<b>Pouilly Fumé 2018 Ch. de L'Abbaye Morlat, Loire (France)</b> Cracking Sauvignon Blanc with grapefruit and lychee character underpinned with a gentle smoky character.			£37

27	<b>Beaujolais Villages 2017 Cave de Fleurie, Beaujolais (France)</b> Cave de Fleurie was founded in 1927 by the women of Fleurie who had taken over the running of much of the appellation during the First World War. Today the Cave is recognised as one of the leading cooperatives in France. A lovely, fresh Beaujolais from vineyards around Fleurie. Strawberry, raspberry and red cherry notes on the nose and silky tannins, this is an ideal partner to pates, cured meats or cheeses.			£26

38	<b>Crasto Douro Red 2017 Quinta de Crasto, Douro (Portugal)</b> One of the finest wine houses along the Douro valley so famous for great Port wines. With intense aromas of blackberries and raspberries on the nose, the palate is bursting with wild berry characters. Very ripe fruit with ample tannin and spice.			£26
39	<b>Barolo Ca' Bianca Tenementi DOCG 2014 Piedmont (Italy)</b> Garnet colour tending towards strong purple blue. Intense and ethereal bouquets of vanilla, cloves and clean truffle woodland undergrowth. Full, firm but velvety flavour with a fine, very lingering aftertaste of liquorice and ripe red fruits.			£48
40	<b>Zinfandel The Smoking Loon 2016, Lodi and Paso Robles (California)</b> The 2012 Smoking Loon Old Vine Zinfandel opens with bold aromas of boysenberry, black cherry and a bevy of vanilla nuances. On the palate, this wine is fruit-driven with flavors of pomegranate, black cherry, fresh cranberry and nutmeg. The finish lingers with layers of cherry-lemonade and toasted cedar.			£34
41	<b>Château Musar, G. Hochar 2011, Bekaa Valley (Lebanon)</b> A characterful wine from Bordeaux and Rhône grape varieties. The plucky, bullet-dodging Hochar family have been making ageworthy wines from vineyards high up in the Bekaa Valley (which enjoys perfect growing conditions: no frost or disease, cool winters and not-quite-scorching summers) since 1930. Every vintage they truck freshly-harvested Cabernet, Cinsault, Carignan, Grenache and Mourvèdre to their 18th century cellar in Ghazir, north of Beirut, to make this dense, fragrant, oaky style. Enjoy the spicy baked fruit flavours with 'mezze'.			£48
42	<b>Malbec Gouguenheim Winery 2018, Mendoza (Argentina)</b> From one of the highest estates in Mendoza at 3,600 feet, the ripening period is a long one, helping this wine to be elegant as well as concentrated. Big flavours of cherries and plums, soft tannins, with well-balanced acidity and a long finish. Powerful and impressive.	£6.10	8.50	£26
